



ReNew WA Workshop: Call to Artists

Proposal due by September 1, 2022

About the ReNew WA Grant and Arts WA:

The Chewelah Creative District is pleased to be the recipient of a ReNew Washington Grant for 2022-2023. This reimbursement style grant is earmarked for elective art workshops to be held at the Jenkins High School in Chewelah. The suggested mediums for these workshops are printmaking, painting/drawing, sculpture, photography, although other mediums will be considered. There will be four (4) separate workshops, each 4 or 5 days in length, to be held throughout the 2022-2023 school year. The designated time will be 3:30 - 5:00, after normal school classes, and will be held in October, February, April, and May. (Exact days to be determined.)

The school will provide the sign-up process, classroom, and non-consumables materials. The school does have a kiln. The projected enrollment would be approximately 50 students and there will be a call for volunteer help in the classroom to get the ratio down to 5 kids to 1 adult.

The artist will be required to complete the volunteer background check that is required by State law. The school district has these kits on hand and must be completed at least two weeks prior to the class. To be considered, your application must be received by September 1, 2022. Your application can be emailed or mailed via USPS.

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Artist Workshop Proposal: Please complete in detail what the workshop would entail. Keep in mind the workshop will be taught to students in grades 9-12 in the Jenkins High School art room over the course of 4 to 5 days depending on session date selection. You will have an hour and a half per session (3:30pm to 5pm).

We are asking that all artists interested draft a lesson "Plan A and Plan B". As this is the first time we've done these workshops, we are unsure of what the student interest will be, but we could possibly have 50+ students who might want to participate.

Lesson Plan A is for a smaller enrollment (25 or less) and would be taught over the course of 4 to 5 days depending on the artists preferred session date. Lesson Plan B is if there is a lot of interest (more than 30 students enroll) and we need to have 2 separate groups of students. In this situation the artist would have to pare down their lesson plan into a 2-day course that would be taught twice.

Artists who are chosen to participate in this event will be required to complete a volunteer packet which can be picked up at the Chewelah District Office. This packet will include forms for fingerprinting and a background check. The cost of this will be covered by the grant funds.
